



RoHS Certificate of Compliance

Based on information provided by our suppliers, Array Networks has determined that all of its products placed into service from July 1, 2006 forward are in compliance with the European Union Directive 2002/95/EC on the restriction of use of certain hazardous substances (“**RoHS Directive**”).

RoHS compliant means that:

- 1) Our supplier has confirmed the compliance status of the relevant products to us.
- 2) We have implemented processes to confirm and document this.

Confirmation of compliance status by our suppliers is either because the products do not contain any of the restricted substances referred to in the European Union Commission Decision of August, 18, 2005 (2005/618/EC) in connection with Articles 4 and 5 of the RoHS Directive in concentrations in excess of the values permitted thereunder or because removal of the restricted substances is not technically possible and their existence in the products at levels in excess of these concentrations is allowed as one of the particular applications listed in the Annex to the RoHS Directive.

For purposes of this RoHS Certificate, the maximum concentration values of the restricted substances by weight of homogeneous materials are:

- Cadmium 100 ppm
- Hexavalent chromium 1,000 ppm
- Poly-brominated byphenyls (PBB's) 1,000 ppm
- Poly-brominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE's) 1,000 ppm
- Mercury 1,000 ppm
