

Array Networks WEEE Policy

Array Networks is committed to meeting the requirements of the European Union (EU) Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive. This Directive requires producers of electrical and electronic equipment to finance the take back, for reuse or recycling, of their products placed on the EU market after August 13, 2005.

Array Networks products that are within the scope of the Directive are labeled with a crossed-out "wheelie-bin" symbol, as required by the Directive. It indicates that the product was placed on the market after August 13, 2005 and that end users should segregate the product from other waste at end-of-life.

The WEEE Directive is being implemented in each of the 27 EU countries through national legislation. As a result, the detailed requirements vary considerably throughout the EU, and the Array Networks WEEE compliance approach varies among countries. In each country affected by the WEEE legislation:

- Array Networks offers a product take back service to its business customers.
- For Array Networks consumer products, compliance will be achieved through membership of an appropriate national compliance scheme.
- Array Networks will seek to register as a producer wherever local legislation requires or permits it to do.

The Array Networks initiative to comply with the WEEE Directive is part of the Array Networks Corporate Social Responsibility Policy, which includes:

- Design for environment
- Reduction in the use of hazardous materials
- Product Take back and Recycling
- Supplier responsibility



This symbol on Array Networks product or on its packaging means that it should not be disposed of with your other household waste. It is your responsibility to dispose of your waste equipment separately from the municipal waste stream.

The correct disposal of your old appliance will help prevent potential negative consequences for the environment and human health.

Array Networks is endeavoring to reduce the environmental and human health effects of EEE at the time this equipment is being discarded.

Identifying Array Networks Products

If you require an understanding of when your Array Networks product was manufactured, the serial number code is as follows:

YYWWXRRRR

YY: Year code

WW: Week code

"X" : Product code, can be any alpha character

RRRR: Random number

For example:-
